# **Getting There**

#### What's the closest drop-off point to Town Square?

The Town Square Drop & Go Zone opens at 3pm. Great for a taxi drop-off. Entry via McCaul Street. No parking available here.

### Where is the closest car parking?

On street parking is free but expect to walk 10+ mins along the Indooroopilly hills from the nearest available on-street parking. We have opened up the school oval for pre-paid car parking for this event. Cost is \$5 per car and spaces will sell out! Enter the pre-paid car park from Carnarvon Road. ### How do I get from the car park to Town Square?

If you have pre-paid for a car park on the oval, there you'll also find Walter our shuttle bus driver, who can drive you straight to Town Square. The shuttle bus will keep operating throughout the night, to return you to the prepaid parking area when you're ready to leave the event.

### On the night, how do I find my year group?

In Town Square, look for the white picket fence. There you'll find tables and chairs set up for the alumni. Each table will have a year grouping on it. Drop by the table, and meet up with your fellow class mates. If you can't find them when you arrive at the event check the Class Photo schedule. Each year level is allocated a photo time, and are encouraged to marshal yourselves together at the Town Square photo wall (D4 classroom) for Class Photos together. # Tell me about accessibility

**Pathways & stairs** - the main alumni activities are based in Town Square which is outdoors and has an asphalt surface. There are several areas that are one step up or down from the main level Town Square. It is mostly flat and able to be navigated with a wheelie walker. We recommend that anyone using a wheelie walker is dropped off at the Town Square Drop & Go Zone, entry from McCaul Street. The 4pm School Tour is designed to be a stair-free tour and accessible to alumni with wheelie walkers.

**Auslan Interpreters** - qualified and experienced interpreters are scheduled to be at the 5pm and 6pm School Tours and also at the 6pm Trivia Competition held in the Peter Doherty Theatre. There are also interpreters scheduled at the Main Stage for live music on the school oval. You can visit the Auslan Information marquee beside the Main Stage for interpreter support and event information.
